

Dear Valued Accuride Partner:

We are writing to inform you that Accuride and its U.S. affiliates have reached an agreement with their lenders to restructure the North American business. Accordingly, on October 9, 2024, Accuride Corporation, certain of its U.S. and Canadian affiliates (including Gunite Corporation and KIC, LLC) (collectively, "Accuride") announced that we have voluntarily filed petitions under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code and commenced a proceeding under the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act ("CCAA") in Canada.

Accuride and its subsidiaries are continuing operations and serving customers as usual. Accuride and its subsidiaries are currently placing orders and receiving goods and services as usual and expect to pay suppliers to these subsidiaries for all goods and services received after October 9, 2024, under normal terms.

Accuride has \$30 million in Debtor-in-Possession financing, which is structured to provide sufficient liquidity to continue normal operations and meet post-petition obligations to employees, suppliers and customers as they come due.

For goods and services provided by suppliers to Accuride on or prior to October 9, 2024, payment for outstanding invoices cannot be made without specific court authorization. Payment for goods and services delivered prior to the filing date will be addressed through the Chapter 11 and CCAA process.
